

“Thinking Outside the Palate”

Most soft tissue grafting for recession can now be done without palate surgery.

AlloDerm is as effective as connective tissue when used with a simplified technique that eliminates tedious tunneling. Implant site augmentation with **AlloDerm** generates wider attachment and keratinized gingiva around implants. Grafts to cover cervical caries is another benefit of using AlloDerm for recession treatment. Biologic growth factors **Platelet-Rich Plasma** and **Emdogain** produce rapid soft tissue healing and predictable reattachment.
