World Congress XXIX was one to remember. Attendance for this Congress was over 1,000 doctors and 255 Auxiliary team members. In addition, over 300 representatives from 88 companies occupying 118 exhibition booths filled the Exhibition Hall to make this our most successful Congress ever. The Congress was held at the beautiful Orlando Marriott World Center, September 20-22, 2012.

in Implant Dentistry". The topics covered ranged from cone beam CT diagnosis and treatment planning; the use of growth factors including stem cells; digital impressions from the perspective of the clinician and the laboratory technician; diagnosing, preventing and treating soft tissue esthetic complications, etc.

Of interest was the makeup of the faculty for this World Congress. In addition to having several distinguished clinicians on the program, Dr. Russo attracted many academicians to the meeting.

As expected, the Pre-Congress courses, which were offered on Thursday morning, September 20th by our Sponsors, had large and enthusiastic audiences.

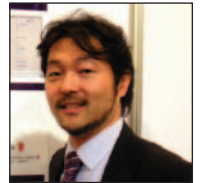

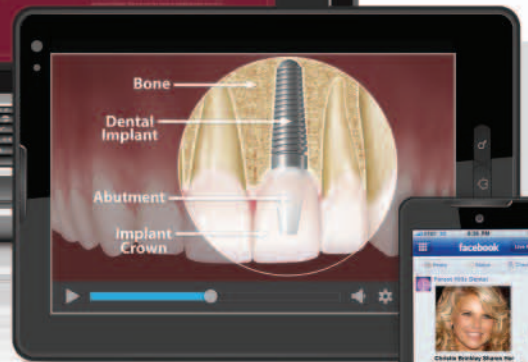

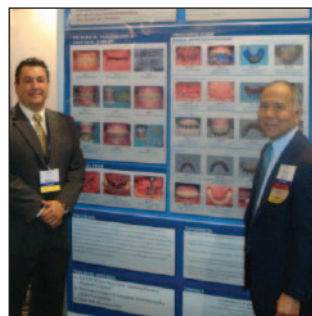
Costa Rica Implant Program Celebrates 11 Years of Implant Education

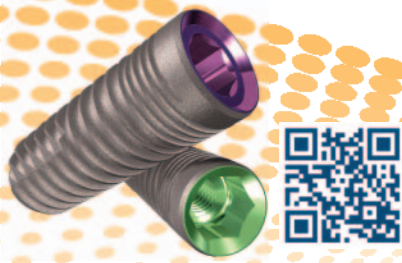

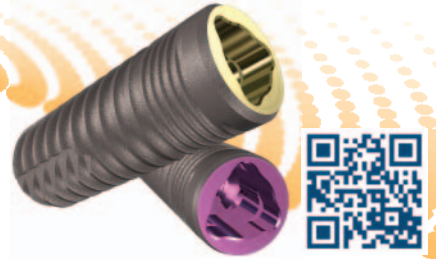

ICOI's 9th SENAME and 2nd ICOI HELLAS International Implant Symposium

Maintenance Requirements for Advanced Credentialed Members

Just because you've attained your advanced credentials, it doesn't stop there.

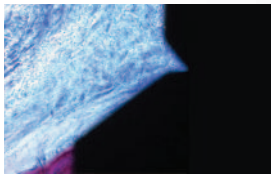
